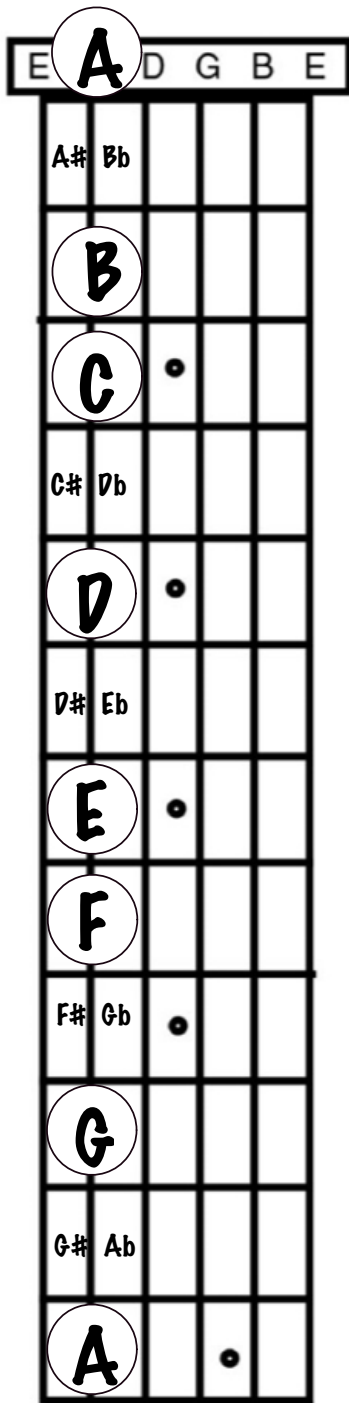


NOTE NAMING

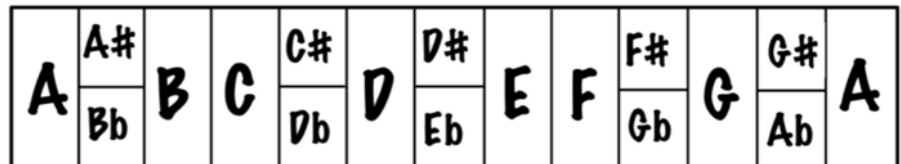
Notes (using the letters of A through to G) are named in strict alphabetic sequence

A B C D E F G A B C D E F G A B C D.....



Below and to the left are graphics explaining how note naming works on a guitar

The same pattern and sequence applies all over the guitar neck starting from any note on any string



“Intervals”

The distance between any two notes is called an “interval”

Any interval of two frets (eg. C to D) is called a “whole step”

Any interval of one fret (eg C to either C# or Db) is called a “half-step”
